Colour City Dance is a Ballet school focused on providing a positive dance experience for all students. We encourage a supportive and respectful culture. The dance experience we provide is age appropriate and underpinned by the international acclaimed RAD level-based syllabus [www.rad.org.au](http://www.rad.org.au) which our ballet classes are based on.

Our aim is to provide our students with a broad range of performance opportunities which competitions (dance eisteddfods) play a part but we also like to see our students dance at community events (such as we did in 2019 including: Ronald McDonald Fundraising Ball, Carols by Candlelight and our annual concerts.

Petite students' classes can be view each week through studio 2 viewing window.

Our weekly morning classes are small and are capped at 8 students per class. All classes can be viewed by parents and carers through our viewing window. **Our focus is nurturing a love of dance and having fun and developing a basis of technique.....**

We offer quality ballet (Royal Academy of Dance syllabus), Jazz, Musical Theatre and Tap classes for 6-8 Years.

### Uniform

**Girls:** red leotard + skirt, ballet tights or socks, ballet shoes, tan jazz shoes for jazz and musical theatre, tan tap shoes for tap, hair in neat bun. (For tap and musical theatre students can also wear black short tights and a red colour city dance t-shirt)

**Boys:** Red Colour City Dance T-shirt and black shorts, white or black ballet shoes, jazz shoes for jazz, tap shoes for tap

## DANCE CLASSES FOR 9 – 12 YEARS

Class Times – Please refer to timetable for class times

### Uniform

- **Junior Contemporary** – Class leotard (black) & footless black tights or black shorts. No shoes. (Attend Dubbo and Orange Eisteddfod). **# Note need to attend one ballet class to do contemporary.**
- **10/12 Years Jazz** – Class leotard (black) black tights or shorts. Studio T-shirt. Tan jazz shoes. (Attend Dubbo and Orange Eisteddfod). **# Note need to attend one ballet class to do Jazz.**
- **Ballet Grades** – Grade 2/3/4/5 Ballet leotard (black or navy), ballet tights, ballet shoes, optional skirt. Based on RAD Ballet Syllabus. Exams are offered for students attending 2 ballet classes per week. These classes perform in the ballet concert.
- **Tap** – Class leotard (black), black shorts, optional Colour City Dance t-shirt. Girls - tan tap shoes, Boys – black tap shoes. (Attend Dubbo and Orange Eisteddfod)
- **Musical Theatre** – Class leotard (black), black shorts, optional Colour City Dance t-shirt, Girls - tan jazz shoes, Boys – black jazz shoes. (Attend Dubbo and Orange Eisteddfod)
- **HIP HOP** – Class leotard (black), black shorts, joggers or jazz shoes optional Colour City Dance t- shirt. (Attend Orange Eisteddfod)
- **10/12 Years Performance Ballet and Modern Class** – same uniform as ballet grade class. Attends Dubbo / Orange Eisteddfods. **(# Note all students need to attend 2 weekly ballet grade classes to take part in this class.)**

\*Students from 7 years and up need to be enrolled in appropriate age group ballet class to be able to enrol in jazz or contemporary.

\*Students need to attend 2 Ballet Grade classes (separate to performance class) in order to attend the performance ballet / modern class.

### Performance Opportunities

Students perform in Dubbo and Orange eisteddfod as well as our end of year concerts and community events. Participation is optional. A costume may need to be purchased or hired.

(Kingfisher Uniform and Ballet shop in Summer Street has all uniform requirements including Colour City Dance t-shirts and tracksuits)

### **Ballet Extension Program for Dedicated Ballet Students Saturday 10.30am – 11.15am (9 years – 14 Years)**

This class will be held on Saturday mornings with Miss Suzanne, and will aim to provide dedicated ballet students with an additional technique class, aimed at those wishing to improve overall technique.

**(#We have some special performance opportunities coming up in 2021 for this class.)**

## DANCE CLASSES FOR 13 YEAR OLDS TO OPENS

Class Times – Please refer to timetable for class times

### Uniform

- **14 Years / Open Contemporary** – any coloured leotard & black footless tights or black shorts. No shoes. (Attend Dubbo, Orange & other TBC Eisteddfod). **# Note need to attend one ballet class to do Contemporary.**
- **14 Years / Open Jazz** – any coloured leotard, black tights or shorts. Black jazz shoes. (Attend Dubbo, Orange & other TBC Eisteddfod.) **# Note need to attend one ballet class to do Jazz.**
- **Ballet Grades** – Inter Foundation, Intermediate, Advanced 1, Advanced 2, Grade 6/7/8., Ballet leotard black or any colour, ballet tights, optional skirt. Pointe shoes and ballet flats. Based on RAD Ballet Syllabus. Exams are offered for students attending 2 ballet classes per week. (At the discretion of the Principal Miss Suzanne). These classes perform in the ballet concert.
- **14 Years / Open Tap** – Any coloured leotard, black shorts, optional Colour City Dance t-shirt. Girls - tan tap shoes, Boys – black tap shoes. (Attend Dubbo, Orange & other TBC Eisteddfod)
- **14 Years / Open Musical Theatre** – Any coloured leotard, black shorts, optional Colour City Dance t-shirt, black jazz shoes. (Attend Dubbo, Orange & other TBC Eisteddfod).
- **HIP HOP** – Any colour leotard, black shorts, joggers or jazz shoes optional Colour City Dance t-shirt. (Attend Dubbo, Orange & other TBC Eisteddfod)
- **14 Years / Open Performance Ballet and Modern Class** – same uniform as ballet grade class + point shoes. Attends Dubbo, Orange & other TBC Eisteddfods. **#Note all students need to attend 2 weekly ballet grade classes to participate in this class.**

(Kingfisher Uniform Ballet shop in Summer Street has all uniform requirements including Colour City Dance t-shirts and tracksuits).

Students from 7 years and up need to be enrolled in appropriate age group ballet class to be able to enrol in jazz class or contemporary class.

\*Students need to attend 2 Ballet classes (separate to performance class) in order to attend the performance ballet / modern class.

### Performance Opportunities

Students perform in Dubbo, Orange eisteddfod & other TBC (for 14's and Opens) as well as our end of year concerts and community events. Participation is optional. All classes take part in our end of year concerts. A costume may need to be purchased or hired.

Please note the following:

- Our *Petite Ballerinas (5 Years & Under)* classes are capped at 8 students per class, to ensure all students are given the appropriate amount of guidance and care
- Fees are capped for families if they exceed \$1350.00
- Students who participate in 1 class per term are required to pay by the first day of term.
- Students who participate in 2 or more classes, fees are due by second week of term
- All fees are paid per term. Any missed classes can be made up during the year.
- (For students doing more than 1 Class) If you elect to pay in instalments fees are to be paid in 4 instalments over the term. Please email the principal to request payment by instalments.
- Parents of students doing private lessons must pay their ballet fees as per the agreed payment method otherwise private lessons will be suspended until dance fees are up to date.

## PRIVATE LESSONS

- Private lessons are a great way to develop technique, learn a new routine or practice for eisteddfod competitions in a one-on-one environment. Students can also practice exam work which is beneficial when coming up to ballet exam time.
- Lessons need to be organised through Miss Suzanne. Miss Suzanne will find a suitable teacher and that teacher will then contact the parent to liaise with regarding a suitable time etc.
- Lessons @ *colourcitydance* are charged @ \$35 per half hour which is paid directly to the teacher. Guest teachers may charge more.
- Parents notify the teacher 24 hours in advance if your child is unable to attend the private lesson. If you do not notify the teacher, you will still need to pay for the lesson.
- Eisteddfod information can be found online. Some local eisteddfods include Forbes, Cowra, Orange, Bathurst, Wellington, Dubbo. Please see your teacher if you require assistance with entries. We encourage parents to be responsible for lodgement of entries.
- Tutu hire for solos is available. It includes a headpiece/tiara for the year. Please see your teacher to arrange hire of a costume. Tu-tu hire cost is \$75 for the year. Other costumes \$45 to hire for the year.
- We also have a private fb group for solo students that we post information on etc.
- For those who would prefer to purchase tutu's, here are some good places to look at on Facebook: - 'Dance Costume Garage Sale', 'preloved tutu's', 'ready to wear tutus.
- We encourage all students to practice at home so that they are prepared when they attend their private lesson. Teachers will send video to parents for child to practise.
- All routines remain within the studio. Each routine is the teachers IP.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2020

### **Our agreement with you**

As parent/ student these terms and conditions form the basis of your agreement with Colour City Dance. Enrolment is compulsory before commencing class.

### **Refunds, Discounts and Credits**

**As fees are paid by term**, no refunds or discounts or credits are given for missed classes or if students leave during the term. Students can attend another class to make up for missed classes.

### **Class Requirements**

Colour City Dance request that students are taken to the toilet before class. Students need to be punctual, well presented and dressed in uniform. All students must do a ballet class. It is up to the Principals discretion when this term may change.

### **Fees**

Fees are charged on a per term basis.

Fees are to be paid by the due date on the invoice.

If fees are paid in instalments the total of the term fees must be paid by the end of that term in 4 equal instalments agreed to with the principal. Your invoice email will reflect payment dates.

We reserve the right to withdraw your child's enrolment for unpaid fees.

Ballet fees must be up to date as per the agreed payment method for students to be able to participate in private lessons.

Interest of 7.5% will be charged on the unpaid amount monthly. Legal action will be taken to recover the unpaid fees, the costs of which will be borne by you. Parents acknowledge that there are additional costs and the same conditions apply for any additional costs outstanding.

Only 1 account will be sent out for a student's dance fees. There is no bill splitting.

**If I wish to withdraw my child from classes I need to inform Colour City Dance by email before the commencement of term or I will be liable to pay fees etc.**

### **Payment**

Payment methods are PayPal, EFT, cheque or cash (all cash payments must be in an envelope, with name, date and amount).

### **Communications**

Parents are responsible for their own IT virus protection.

Please do not disturb teachers during class time. Discussions with teachers directly can be arranged via appointment.

### **Costume Hire**

All costumes hired by students need to be returned to the studio when requested or direct otherwise the cost to purchase a new costume will be charged to your account.

### **Working with Children**

All employees, contractors, sub-contractors, parent helpers are required to have a working with children check if working with Colour City Dance students.



### **Conduct for learning in the School**

Any behaviour by parents or students which may affect other students or parents or the delivery of teaching or the operations, earning capacity or the reputation of Colour City Dance will result in dismissal from the School and possible further legal action. All costs associated with any legal action will be borne by the parents.

### **Consent**

You consent to Colour City Dance employees, helpers or contractors taking your child to the toilet if required, apply first aid in the event of an emergency, physical contact in relation to dance correction and instruction, take photographs for Colour City Dance promotional or marketing activities and understand to the risk associated with dance activities and the possibility of injury (as outlined in Clause)

### **Limit of Liability**

Colour City Dance does not exclude or limit-

the application of any provision of any statute (including the Trade Practices Act 1974) where to do so would contravene that statute or cause any part of this clause 7 to be void; or

direct losses and damages which arise only as a result of Colour City Dance gross negligence (which means where Colour City Dance commits an act or allows an omission to occur in reckless disregard the consequences of the act or omission). Colour City Dance excludes all statutory liability (including but not limited to liability in negligence), the general law or statute, liability for all direct, economic, consequential or indirect losses, expenses, damages, and costs incurred by you, arising out of or relating to the attendance at class, including, but not limited to, liability for gross negligence, Colour City Dance is not responsible or liable for any indirect consequential or economic damage.

### **COVID -19**

If classes are unable to continue in a physical space, they will be continued on Zoom in original or amended format depending on the class.

All parents, visitors and students are required to adhere to COVID -19 requirements.

Colour City Dance complies with NSW GUIDELINES but is not liable in the case of students/ parents / visitors contracting COVID -19. All those entering the studio are responsible for taking COVID-19 safety measures.
